Helicopter Over Monserrat Volcano

We fly directly to the East Coast of Montserrat at 1,500 feet, our captain will provide commentary over the headsets that we are all fitted with. At the centre of Montserrat's exclusion zone is the Soufriere Hills Volcano. Rising to 3,000 feet, it is still active and frequently emits a combination of ash, steam and smoke.

Barbados Island Safari

This tour will appeal to those of us who enjoy soft adventure. Leaving the port by 4x4 Land Rovers, we will pass Gun Hill Signal Station and its stone-carved lion. Soon we venture off-road, for a view of what the island probably looked like when it was first settled in the 16th century. We stop at Bathsheba, for a view of the rugged coastline and the pounding surf of the Atlantic Ocean.

St Maarten Island Tour and Butterfly Farm

Discover numerous rare and exotic butterflies fluttering freely around us. We will also witness the various stages of the butterfly's life cycle and also have the opportunity to handle these fragile creatures and the caterpillars. As our coach climbs the hill, we will stop at Orient Beach, perhaps one of the most popular beaches in the Caribbean.

Deep Sea Fishing

The warm waters off the coast of Barbados offer ideal fishing for Barracuda, Tuna, Wahoo, Dolphin (Dorado), and the Marlin species.

Most charters include drinks, all tackle and bait.

Rainforest Aerial Tram St Lucia

The aerial tram will provide us with a bird's eye view of a truly mature Caribbean oceanic rainforest. Nurtured by warm, gentle rains and rich volcanic soils, St Lucia's forests have achieved a state of ancient majesty.

Beach Watersports

From scuba diving the reefs and exploring the numerous ship wrecks, snorkeling with the turtles, to the speed and thrill of Jet Skiing, the highs of Parasailing or simply lazing on the sun deck of a sailing catamaran. Windsurfers and Kite Surfers from around the globe head for Silver Sands in Christchurch, and surfers hunt for the perfect wave at Bathsheba on Barbados East Atlantic Coast.

Mamiku Gardens St Lucia

Passing through the centre of the island, we will traverse the cool mountain ranges, which are covered with the Barre de L'Isle rainforest. Shadowed by great trees, via a wooded road, which passes through a typical example of St Lucia's dry forest, we reach Mamiku Gardens. The beautiful gardens overlook picturesque Praslin Bay and the Atlantic Ocean.

Pirates Bay treasure tour

You can suntan on the top deck, rope-swing or join the pirates on the Jolly Barge for a side trip to snorkel and swim with the fascinating sea turtles at the beach stop and even get married at sea (pirate style of course) or plan your next raid and plunder mission!

Barbados Coast to Coast

Continuing through the suburbs of Bridgetown, we will soon see the more rural scenery that Barbados has to offer. We pass by the Emancipation Statue, depicting a freed slave, which commemorates the abolition of slavery. Gun Hill Signal Station, high on a hill, appears before us as we ascend through the parish of St George. We will also notice the large statue of a lion, carved from a single piece of coral, which was made by an English army captain named Wilkinson, in 1868.

Flightseeing tour of St Lucia by Helicopter

This tour entails a spectacular flight over the beautiful island of St Lucia. We fly over Castries Harbour before journeying to the south of the island. View the picturesque fishing villages and golden beaches before reaching the highlight of the tour – the striking Pitons, rising 760 metres (2,500 feet) out of the Caribbean waters! We will also see the unique volcanic Sulphur Springs, with steam rising from the bubbling crater!
